

## UPDATES 14<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2025

Westwood Farm Kambah to Yarralumla updated notes from 8.1km, 3 routes to Molonglo River at 13.1 as per mapped directions

### ROUTE ONE HORSE/HIKING ROUTE

Contact Section Coordinator Jenny for further updates as construction of new school may temporarily close route exiting Stromlo Forest Park.

**8.1** 2.6 Just before T section of Eucumbene Drive /Warragamba Avenue continue on Equestrian Trail inside fenced corridor to caveletti on Cotter Road. Cross road into caveletti into Stromlo Forest Parks well marked with NT triangles (Ignore interpretive signage, not changed as yet). Continue straight on ignoring trails left and right. You will be safe away from busy cycling areas on this dedicated NT equestrian trail. Exit caveletti and cross Uriarra stub road to John Gorton Drive Horse underpass and follow equestrian signage to Southwell Crossing on your left.

**12.6** Cross Southwell Crossing turn right on first forestry trail which joins up to 13.0 as previously mapped.

### **12.6 ROUTE TWO ALTERNATIVE TRAIL IF MOLONGO RIVER FLOODED.**

If Southwell Crossing is flooded the causeway to Yarralumla Campsite will also be flooded. Continue on until Large Clos Bridge **but do not cross**. Cross small pedestrian/horse bridge before on your right follow cycle path to below the Yarralumla camp. Beware this is a busy cycle path with limited verge for horses.

### **12.6 ROUTE THREE ALTERNATIVE ROUTE for cyclist, horses and hikers.**

**8.1** At T-intersection of Eucumbene Drive/Warragamba Avenue. Turn right to travel on wide grass verge North side of Warragamba Ave and Dixon Dr

**10.5** Turn left after small creek bridge past Community Garden and follow Cotter Road left equestrian side of underpass. **Cyclists can take right side of divided underpass which is the main cycle path to below Yarralumla camp opposite the causeway crossing.**

Horses continue on grass Turn right before the concrete causeway between the ponds and follow around ponds to old cycle path sighting the rough track on the left to the pedestrian/horse bridge and follow river downstream turn right to cross Southwell low level Crossing.

**13.0** Turn right on forestry trail to continue NE beside Molongo River to under Tuggeranong Parkway as described in notes.

NB. Local government has requested horses not to use high Clos Bridge hence NT route uses Southwell Crossing.
